#### RESOLUTION

# GOVERNMENT OF ODISHA. DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

No. 105 WR, Bhubaneswar, dated 81515

Sub: - Implementation of a New State Plan Scheme: "Revival of defunct Lift Irrigation Project under OLIC."

The State has a cultivable area of 61.65 lakh Ha. It has been assessed that 8.90 lakh Ha. of cultivable land can be provided with irrigation facilities through Lift Irrigation Projects. Odisha Lift Irrigation Corporation was established to exploit the surface and ground water resources through different LIP schemes formulated by Govt. Since its inception in 1973, 23596 nos. of Community Lift Irrigation Projects have been installed with Cultivable Command Area (CCA) of 523349 Ha by the end of 2013-14. Out of these, 6916 LIPs with CCA of 1,57,560 Ha are in defunct condition due to various reasons such as expiry of life span, damage of head works, damage of distribution system, natural calamities (cyclone/flood), theft of transformer, conductor etc. The State Govt. have attached top priority to irrigation sector and resolved to revive all the defunct LIPs wherever revival is possible. It is assessed that out of 1837 L.I.Ps with Cultivable Command Area (CCA) of 42409 Ha are permanently defunct which cannot be revived due to change of river course, drying up of water source, conversion of agricultural ayacut to homestead land due to urbanization etc. Remaining 5079 LIPs having CCA of 115151 Ha can be revived.

- 2. A detailed strategy has been worked out to revive of 5447 nos. of defunct lift irrigation projects (5079 LIPs + 20% of permanently defunct LIPs) by dovetailing funds from all sources. It is planned that 1674 LIPs will be taken up from other sources of funding such as RIDF, SCA, ADB and other Agencies. 3773 LIPs will be taken up under a new state plan scheme to be funded out of state's own plan resources during the next five years i.e.2014-15 to 2018-19.
- 3. Accordingly, Government in Water Resources Department has decided to launch a new state plan scheme i.e. "Revival of defunct L.I. Projects" to be implemented during 2014-15 to 2018-19 for revival of 3773 LIPs with an outlay of ₹521.85 crore. This scheme will be implemented by OLIC Ltd. The salient features of the new scheme are as under:
- (A) The scheme aims at revival of 3405 nos. of temporarily defunct LIPs and 368 nos. of permanently defunct LIPs.

# (E) Project implementation, monitoring and evaluation.

Existing administrative arrangement of the Department of Water Resources and the implementing agency i.e. OLIC will be utilized for implementing the project. The Present fund flow mechanism will be followed.

There is State level and Circle level monitoring team which will monitor the quality of work and best quality of materials are being utilized by the contractor for the work.

The measurable parameters for evaluation of impact/outcome are:

- The irrigated area (Stabilization of ayacut area) will be increased.
- ii) There will be increase in crop yield which can be visualized on the field and will be reported by DoA.
- Socio economic condition of farmers will be increased which can be known after sample survey.

The evaluation work (mid-term/Concurrent/post project) will be assigned to 3rd party through proper procedure.

The scheme has been appraised by the Expenditure Finance Committee on 17.01.2015 and approved by the State Cabinet vide Parliamentary Affairs Department Notification No.1983 dt.28.04.2015.
