INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)

The Superintending Engineer, Drainage Division, Bhadrak on behalf of Governor of Odisha invites on-line **percentage rate tender** through e-procurement in **single cover system** for execution of works under S.I.A. The bids should be submitted by eligible class of contractors registered / empanelled with state Government of Odisha & contractors of equivalent grade / class registered with other State Governments / central Government / Government undertakings / MES / Railways / other statutory authorities/ registered firms/ Consultancy firms for execution of works to be eventually drawn in P-1 form through on-line in the Government website <http://www.tendersodisha.gov.in>. The bidders should have necessary portal enrollment (with own digital signature certificate). The registered bidders outside of Odisha state can also participate in this on-line tender process after necessary portal enrollment but shall have to subsequently undergo registration with appropriate authority of the State Govt. within a month of acceptance of bid.

- The bidders have to participate in online bidding only. The website for online bidding is <http://www.tendersodisha.gov.in>.
- The bid documents will be available in the above-mentioned website from **10.00 Hours of 02.03.2026 to 12.03.2026 up to 17.00 Hours** for online bidding.
- Date of opening of Bid – **11.30 Hours on 13.03.2026** office of the Superintending Engineer, Drainage Division, Bhadrak.
- The bidder shall transfer online the Earnest Money deposit / Bid Security of the amount & the cost of bid paper (non-refundable) specified for the work in the table Col. 6 & Col. 7 respectively as part of this bid through a process as mentioned under DTCN.
- Mode of Bid / Period of availability of bid on-line / date and time of bidding on-line / Last date of seeking clarification / date of opening of bid papers.
- Bid validity:** - The bid for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the last date of receipt of bids. If any bidder withdraws his bid before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and condition of the bid, he will be suspended for 3 (Three) years as per office Memorandum No.8943/F dt.18.03.2021 of Finance deptt. Govt. of Odisha.
- No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering department of the State Government is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without permission of Government.
- The original documents along with a set of it's Xerox copies against the scanned copy of RC, (valid contractor registration certificate)/ valid Firm/ valid Consultant registration certificate, GSTIN registration Certificate, PAN Card, Affidavit and requisite documents submitted through web site should be produced in the office of Superintending Engineer, Drainage Division, Bhadrak for verification on demand after opening the Technical Bid.
- Any addendum / corrigendum /cancellation of above tender will be published in the web-site www.tendersorissa.gov.in and in the notice board. The system shall generate a mail to those bidders who have already uploaded their tenders and those bidders if they wish, can modify their tenders.

11. Only those bidders who successfully remit their Cost of Tender Paper on submission of bids would be eligible to participate in the tender/ bid process. The bidders with pending or failure payment status shall not be able to submit their bid. Tender inviting authority, State Procurement Cell, NIC, the designated Banks shall not be held responsible for such pendency or failure.
12. Bid document consisting of qualification, information and eligibility criteria of bidders, plans, specification and schedule of quantities of the works are available in web-site www.tendersodisha.gov.in and the set of terms and conditions of contract and other necessary documents can be seen in the web-site till last date of sale and receipt of tender papers. Interested tenderers may obtain further information at the web-site www.tendersodisha.gov.in.
13. Other details including details of Portal Registration, Submission of bid, Re-submission and withdrawal of bid can be seen in the bidding document which is available in web-site www.tendersodisha.gov.in.
14. Engineering contractor who is desirous to avail the facility of exemption of EMD is required to submit the affidavit (Duly signed by the Oath taking Commissioner / Notary) in on-line to the effect that he/she has want to availed the EMD Exemption and not yet availed the facility for more than two works during the current financial year, failing which the tender will liable for rejection.
15. Additional Performance Security (As per Memorandum No. 173/W Dated 03.01.2026) shall be furnished by the bidder when the bid amount is less than the estimated cost put to tender. Only the successful bidder who has quoted less bid price/rates than the estimated cost put to tender shall have to furnish Additional Performance Security (As per Memorandum No. 173/W Dated 03.01.2026) in shape of Term Deposit Receipt pledged in favour of Divisional Officer/ Bank Guarantee in favour of the Divisional officer i.e. Superintending Engineer, Drainage Division, Bhadrak from any Nationalized/Scheduled Bank in India counter guaranteed by its local branch at Bhubaneswar within seven days of issue of letter of acceptance(LOA) by the concerned Officer (by e-mail) to the successful bidder otherwise the bid of the successful bidder shall be cancelled & the Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security shall be forfeited. Further, proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against the bidder.
16. As per Office Memorandum No.173/W, Dt. 03.01.2026 of Works Department (Ref:-Section-5), the Additional Performance Security (APS) shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under:
 - I. Where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid, no additional performance guarantee/security percentage is required.
 - II. Where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid, the additional performance guarantee/security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
 - III. Where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid, the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
 - IV. The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more.
 - V. The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.
 - VI. Justification for abnormally low bids shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the Bid price, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the Bidder, including detailed price analyses of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document., If, after evaluating the price analyses, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the Procuring Entity may reject the Bid/ Proposal, However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.
17. If the rate quoted by more than one bidder is found to be equal and lowest, then the tender will be finalized by a transparent lottery system in the Office Chamber of the Superintending Engineer, Drainage Division,

Bhadrak where all bidders / their authorized representatives, the concerned SE/ EE of concerned Division and DAO will remain present. If the scheduled date either for opening of tender or lottery for finalization of tender is declared as a Govt. holiday then the same will be conducted in the next working day.

18. Individual SC & ST contractors having been so mentioned in the Contractor's Registration Certificate (up to "B" class) have to claim in the affidavit for availing 10% purchase preference at the time of submission of bid otherwise the above preference shall not be allowed. No further correspondence will be made with them and no claim will be entertained in this regard.
19. If the rate quoted by the SC & ST Category contractors comes to the rate quoted by the L1 bidder after availing 10% price preference as per Para 2 of Works Department Resolution No.27748 Dt-11.10.1977, the tender shall be finalized by the tender accepting authority through a transparent lottery system along with other categories of contractors.
20. If the 1st lowest bidder does not turn up for agreement after finalization of tender, then he shall be debarred from participation in bidding for three years & action will be taken to black list the contractor as per codal provision in Annexure-II of Amendment to Para-3.4.14 Note-I of OPWD Code Vol-1.
21. Labour license is to be produced by the successful bidder before commencement of work.
22. For a particular work a bidder can submit only one bid. Submission of more than one bid by a bidder for a particular work will be liable for rejection of all such bids of the concerned bidder.
23. The bidder should mention his detail address and phone/mobile no. and e-mail address in the separate sheet for communication regarding the tender.
24. The single tender received in the first call shall be cancelled without opening the bid. The acceptance of the single tender received even after retendering should have prior approval of next higher authority vide O.P.W.D. Para-3.5.18 of Office memorandum no 16/W dated 01.01.2015.
25. As Goods and Service Tax has come into force with effect from 01.07.2017, GST as applicable will be paid extra after gross bill amount prepared vide Section-15 and Section-142 (11-C) of Odisha Goods and Service Tax Act 2017.
26. **All correspondence to the bidders will be made by e-mail address given by them in the bid confirmation report of e-procurement system Government of Odisha along with the bid. The authority will not be responsible for invalid e-mail address.**
27. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRACTORS (vide DOWR Letter No.20415 dt.14.09.2015)**
 - (i) Any Agency or contractor executing a work should be aware about the local festivals like Makar Sankranti, Raja Sankranti, Chaiti Parba, Danda Nata or any such festivals which may affect the work schedule. Therefore, the contractors should engage more work forces during working period available at his disposal to complete the work as per schedule.
 - (ii) In the peak summer season, working hour is curtailed by the Labour Department to avoid exposure to personnel to the scorching sun and heat. It is the duty of the agency to increase the number of workforce and to employ the existing workforce during morning and afternoon hour as per Government orders.
 - (iii) Rainfall is a normal occurrence during monsoon in Odisha. So, unless there is unusually heavy rainfall resulting in a declared calamity, the Contractor is not eligible for any extension of time. The Contractor should plan the deployment of workforce and machinery, so as to complete the work as per schedule considering ordinary vagaries of the nature.
 - (iv) The same applies for borrow areas ponding also. The Contractor should foresee possible ponding of borrow area in monsoon and therefore lift more quantity of soil/ other materials during dry period, so as to complete the work as per schedule.
 - (v) The Contractor should take up the work with due diligence in the acquired land without waiting for acquisition of the entire land. This should be completed in proportionally less period depending on the quantum of available work front.
 - (vi) The Agency should plan his work programme and mobilize men and machineries considering the canal closure programme of a particular system of area. Khariff/ Rabi closure can't be imposed arbitrarily on the farmers as per the convenience of the agency. Closure of canal for the interest of work will be solely at discretion of the Engineer-in Charge and can't be claimed as a matter of right.

(vii) There will always be standing crop before harvesting season as per crop schedule and this fact has to be clearly understood by the agency. Extension of the time on this ground may not be considered by Divisional Officers.

(viii) Only the day(s) of elections to the Local Bodies/ Assembly/ Parliament will be treated as a non-working days).

28. As per Works Department Government of Odisha office Memorandum No-4281/W, Dated-05/03/2025 for preference to local MSEs / Start-ups in procurement of works.

(i) After careful consideration, Government have been please to withdraw this Department O.M. No. 503/W dt. 17.01.2022 with effect from the date of issue of the Office Memorandum and accordingly the exemption from deposit of Bid security at the time of participation in tender & concessional payment of performance security @25% of the value of performance security to local Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) and Start-ups as extended vide this Department O.M. No. 503/W Dt. 17.01.2022 will no more exist w.e.f the date of issue of the Office Memorandum.


(ii) This Office Memorandum shall be effective from the date of issue. It shall be deemed to be a part of OPWD Code.

29. If, applicable the EMF and DMF of miner minerals will be deducted @ 5% and @ 10% of Royalty of the materials. Besides that, additional charges as fixed by the district administration will be deducted from each bills .

30. Authority reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
